Section 1. PURPOSE.

The Village Code makes no specific provision for the appointment and qualifications of members of the Planning Board. Additionally, it is sometimes difficult to maintain a quorum on the Village of Chester Planning Board because members are ill, on vacation, or find that they have a conflict of interest on a specific matter before the Board. In such instances, official business cannot be conducted which may delay or impede adherence to required time lines. The use of alternate members in such instances is hereby authorized pursuant to the provisions of the Village Law and this local law.

Section 2. The following is added as § 17-3 to the Code of the Village of Chester

§ 17-3. MEMBERS AND ALTERNATES

A. MEMBERS: The Planning Board of the Village of Chester shall consist of five members. Members and the chairperson of such Planning Board shall be appointed by the Mayor, subject to the approval of the Board of Trustees. In the absence of a chairperson, the Planning Board may

designate a member to serve as chairperson. Compensation of Planning Board members shall be as provided in resolutions passed, from time to time, by the Village Board of Trustees. The term of each member shall be five years, with one such term expiring each year. If a vacancy shall occur otherwise than by expiration of term, it shall be filled by the Mayor, with the approval of the Village Board, by appointment for the unexpired term. All provisions of Village Law § 7-718 relating to planning board member and chairman duties, training and continuing education, attendance, conflict of interest, compensation, eligibility, vacancy in office, removal, and service on other boards, shall apply to the members

B. ALTERNATES:

- (1) Up to three alternate members of the Planning Board shall be appointed by the Mayor, subject to the approval of the Board of Trustees, for terms of three years, with one such term expiring each year...
- (2) The Chairperson of the Planning Board may designate an alternate member to substitute for a member when such member is unable to participate on an application or matter before the Board. When so designated, the alternate member shall possess all the powers and responsibilities of such member of the board. Such designation shall be entered into the minutes of the initial planning board meeting at which the substitution is made.
- (3) All provisions of Village Law Section 7-718 relating to planning board member training and continuing education, attendance, conflict of interest, compensation, eligibility, vacancy in office, removal, and service on other boards, shall also apply to alternate members.
- <u>Section 3</u>. SEVERABILITY. In the event that any clause, sentence, section or other part of this Local Law is declared to be invalid, such invalidity shall not affect the remainder of this chapter.
- <u>Section 4</u>. EFFECTIVE. This Local Law shall become effective immediately upon filing with the Office of the Secretary of State pursuant to the Municipal Home Rule Law.
